



Ogemaw Hills Snowmobile Club (OHSC)



was formed in December of 1967 and incorporated in 1972. The club is responsible for grooming 105 miles of trails mainly within Ogemaw County as a grant holder from the Michigan DNR.

The OHSC clubhouse and equipment buildings are located at Frank Alley Memorial Park, at the corner of Fairview and Rose City Roads. The memorial park is named for a noted citizen from West Branch who sold Ski-Doo snowmobiles in the early days. Over three acres of lighted parking, a pavilion and an outhouse is available.

On February 25, 2023, OHSC celebrated its 55th Anniversary including the 11th Annual Vintage Snowmobile Show & Ride. This event is open to the public.

We groom over 100 miles of trails (SNOW AND ORV) in our area year-round. We publish a monthly newsletter for members and have a website that has LOTS of snowmobiling information. Our Clubhouse camera view can be found at ohsconline.com/index.php/snow-cam-live/

We host the Sasquatch Gravel Chase Race in August, sponsored and run by Mid Michigan Health Foundation in West Branch. The Race attracts several hundred visitors to Frank Alley Park and our clubhouse.

We support the Michigan Snowmobile & ORV Association (MISORVA), Michigan Snowmobile Advisory Workshop, Ogemaw County Genealogical Society, Top of the Lake Snowmobile Museum of the Upper Peninsula and the International Snowmobile Hall of Fame. We are also members of the West Branch and Rose City/Lupton Chambers of Commerce and have a booth at the Ogemaw County Fair.

Ogemaw Hills Snowmobile Club members strive to preserve and improve snowmobiling for future generations. With our club expanding each year, we are also able to make improvements like creating and widening trails, purchasing signs and groomers, and other investments to make the trail system safe and enjoyable. We also support our community organizations by donating to local charities and awarding an annual scholarship at Ogemaw Heights High School.

Belonging to a club provides an opportunity to meet other people with the same interest. Looking for someone to ride with? Members are always riding when conditions allow. Membership in the club is family friendly. We have a number of events throughout the year which allow you to meet others and become involved in the expansion and growth of the club.
