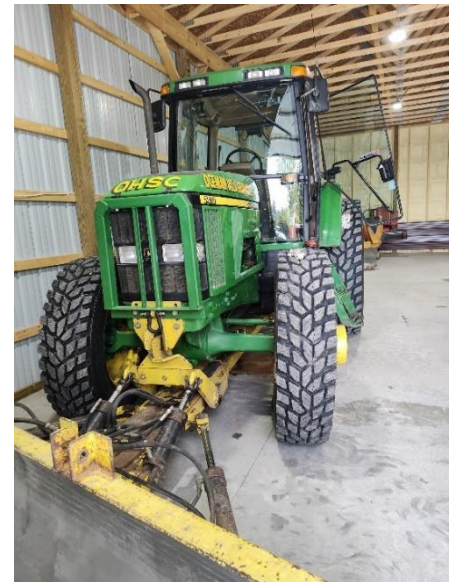

Greg took this photo of the club lot last Saturday. Too bad our trails are not graded.

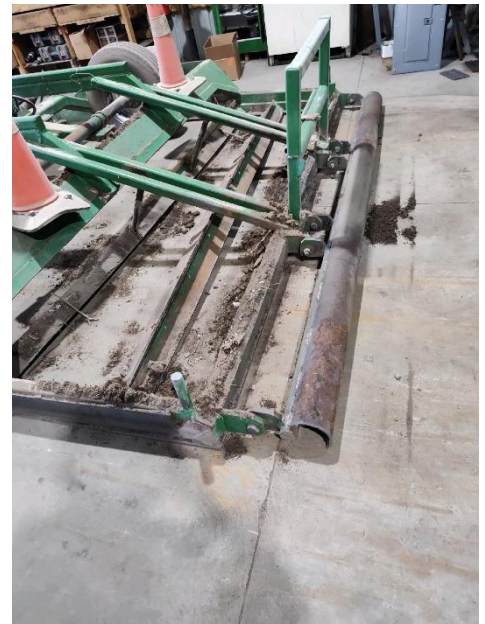


*John spent part of his Memorial Day welding on the dirt drag. He also finished the two feet for the bottom.*

*The new tires have a different tread. They seemed to pull the drag just fine.*

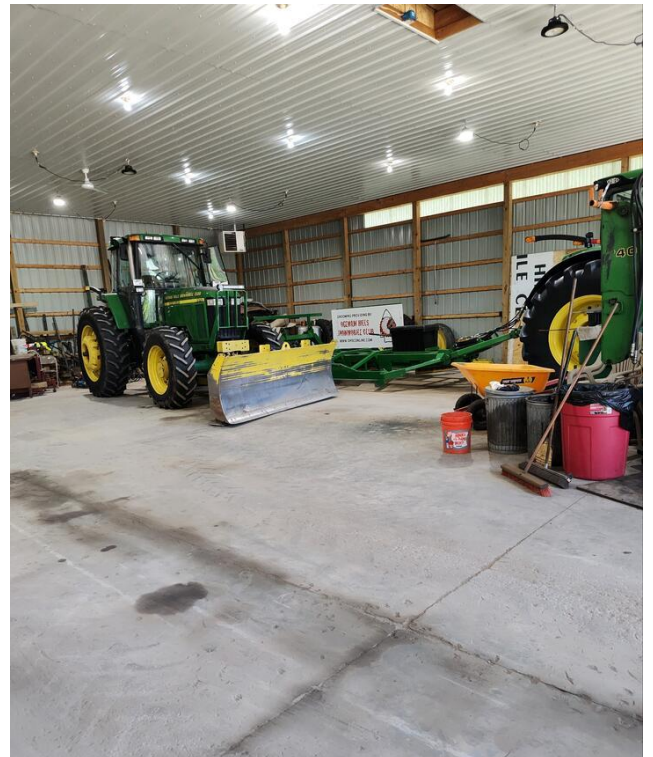

*We allowed the Sheriff ORV to be parked in our barn for the summer to make it easier to patrol the trails.*

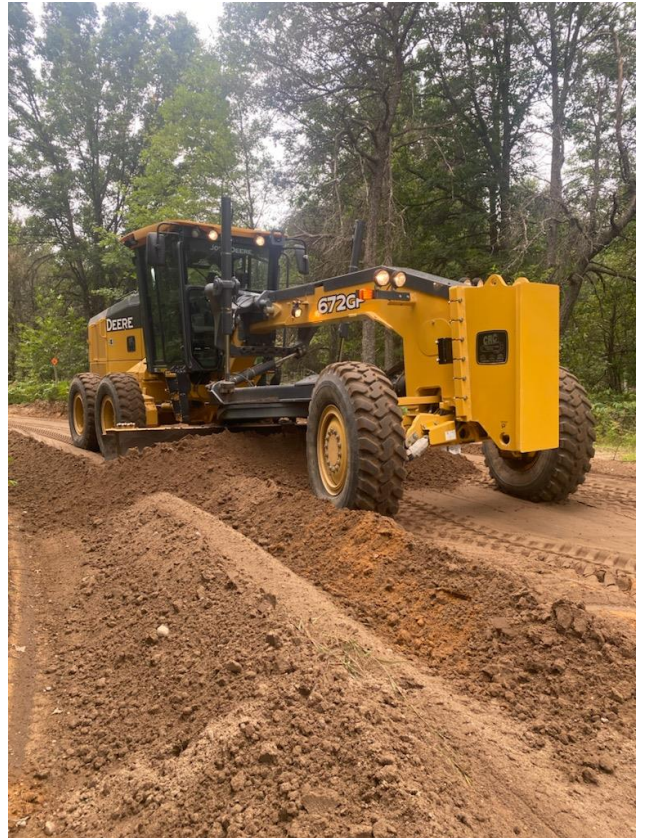
The OGEMAW HILLS ORV ROUTE IS OFFICIALLY OPEN
