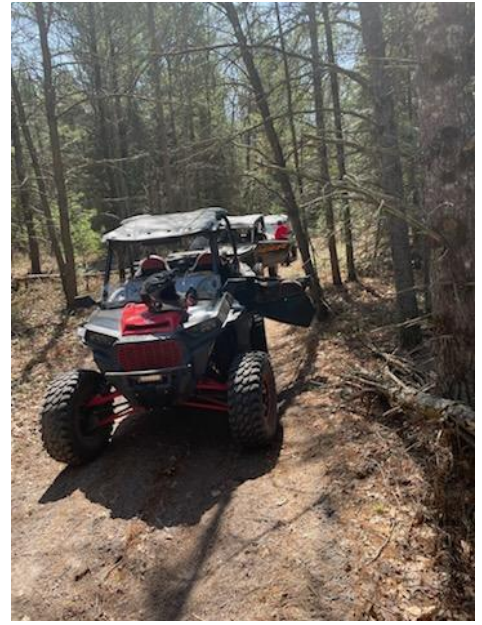


2011 sun chaser 21 ft

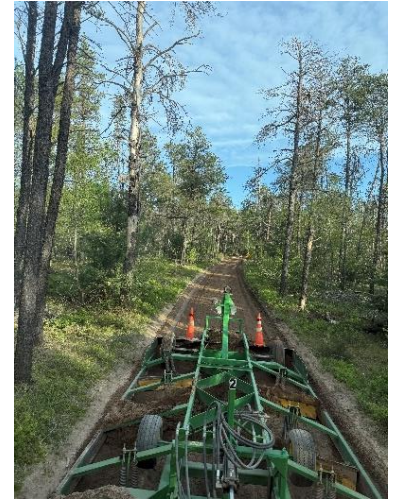

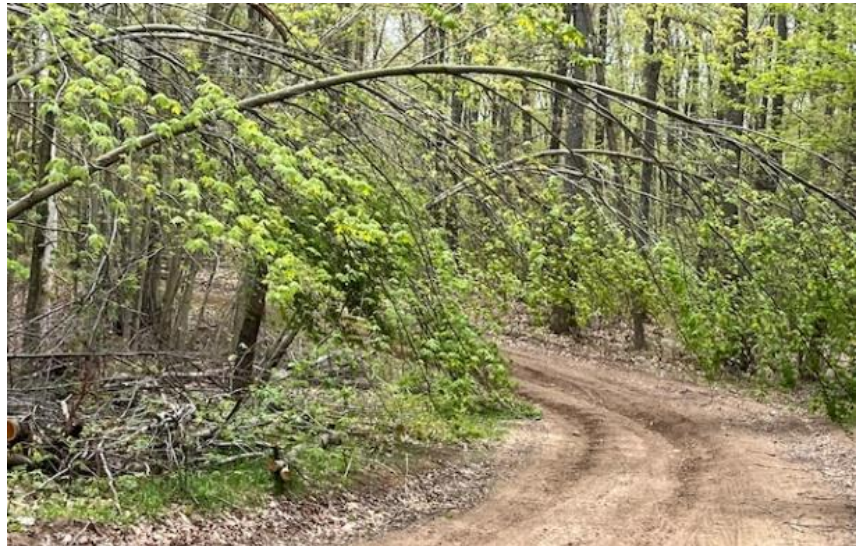


Chavon and Chris Nihls rode from Beechwood to M33 on May 18. Passable but not cleared.

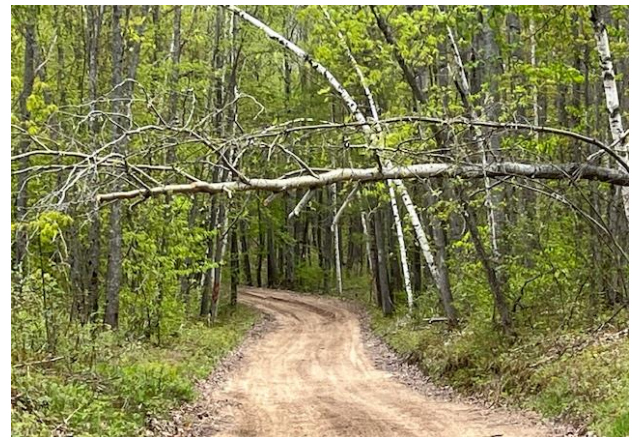


Dan White was grading on both ends. We are finally grading trails.

Chavon and Chris rode from Beechwood Rd. on Trail 6 to M33.



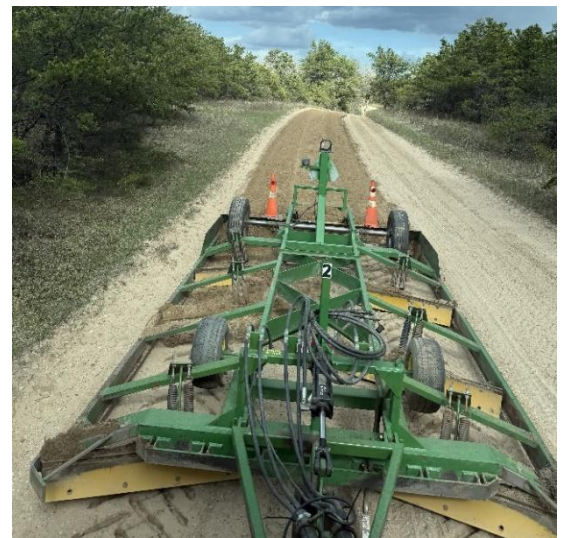
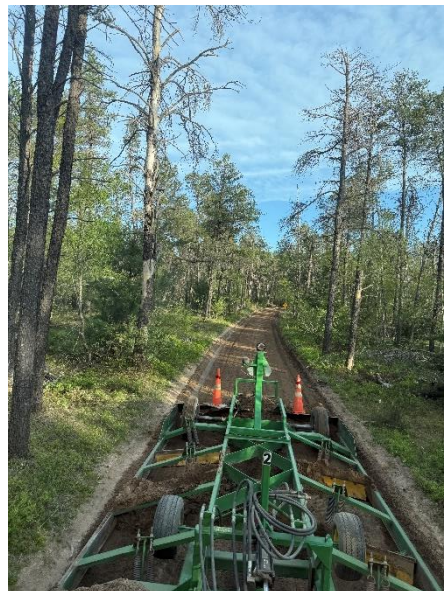
Russ worked the east side using the grader. Some high berms to knock down.
