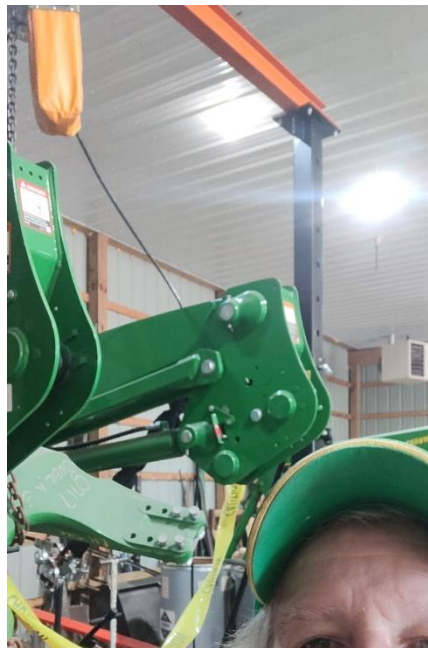

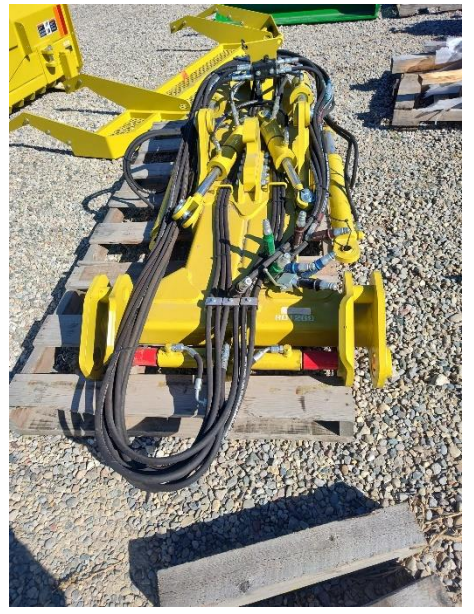

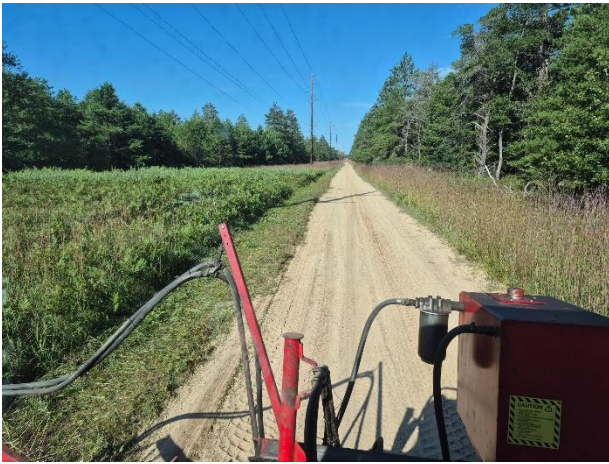

EAST SIDE STORM DAMAGE CLEARING BEGINS 9/6/2025



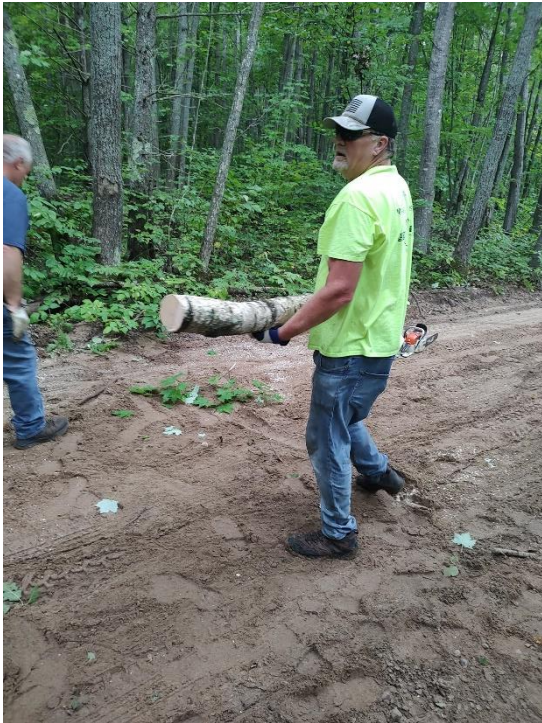
Steve Prueter, John Hurry, Keith Humpert, Tom Zielinski with Skip Schultz on the first day clearing storm damage on the east side.
