2026 OHSC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

This is the 11th consecutive year that the Ogemaw Hills Snowmobile Club (OHSC) is offering a scholarship This year we are pleased to announce we will be donating a \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating high school senior from Ogemaw Heights High School who meets the following requirements:

1. Has shown an interest in Snowmobiling as a recreational activity
2. Plans to further their education in an accredited university, state college, technical or trade school.
[This does NOT have to be related to snowmobiling)
3. Has a GPA of 2.0 or "C" average

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 Include a photo of You. (**Preferably** your Senior Picture) and a Photo of you and your snowmobile **if you have one**. This **is not required** but encouraged.
- 2 One letter of recommendation from a School Administrator, Teacher, Counselor, Coach, or Employer. (Only one letter needed)
- 3 Be available for a scholarship presentation at the OHSC clubhouse - Fairview Rd. West Branch, MI in May.

Scholarships will be given to the winner regardless of other grants or scholarships that the student may also receive.

Note: The OHSC Scholarship Award will be in the form of a check sent directly to your school of choice with your student account number for the Fall term. You must be able to provide your Student Number.

***Non-attendance at the program will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.**
