Dan and Al rode out Friday and stopped at the hut.



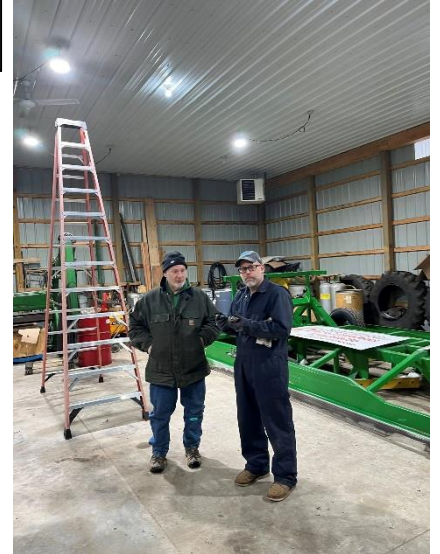


Members gathered to work on Tractor Maintenance Day 2025.

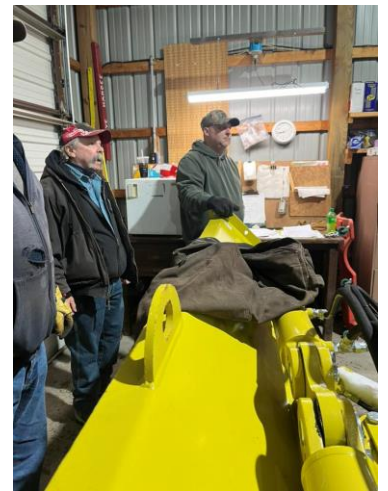
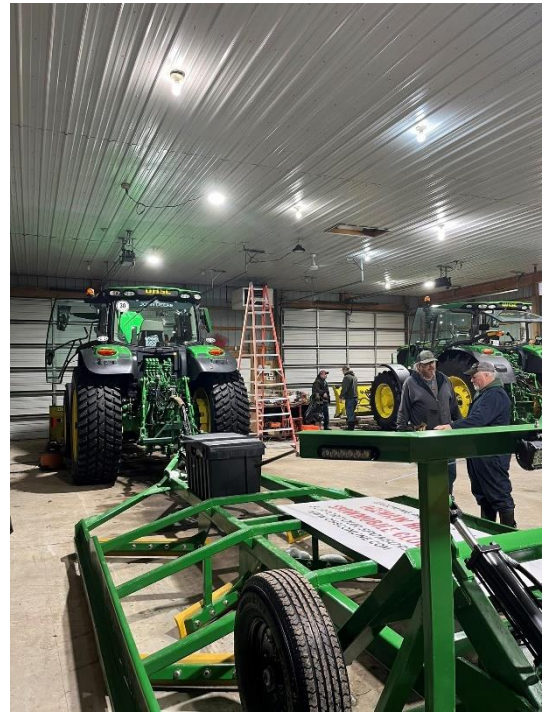
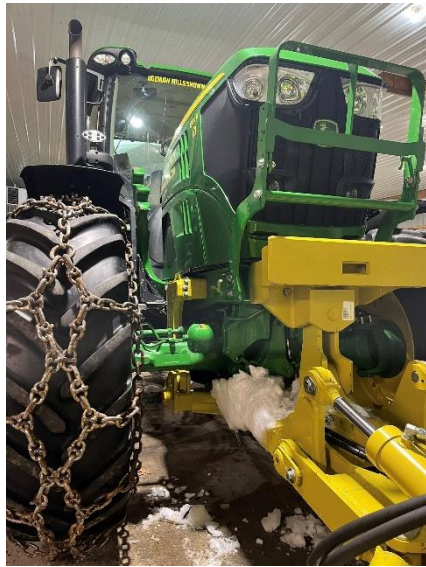


Debbie is the official windshield washer for the club.

Member Jeff Hartley and his brother stopped after leaving South Branch.



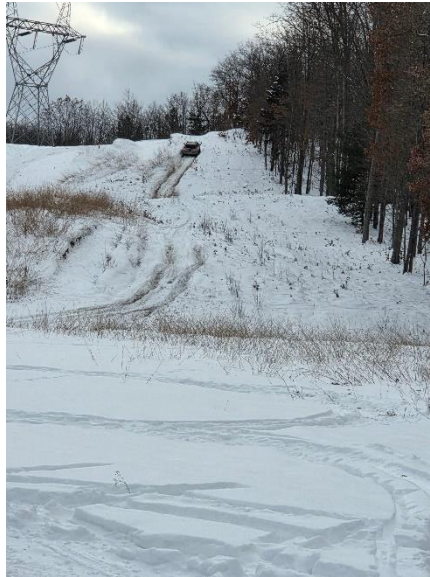
Tim got some ride time before the dinner.
