Lyle Curry was on the trails.

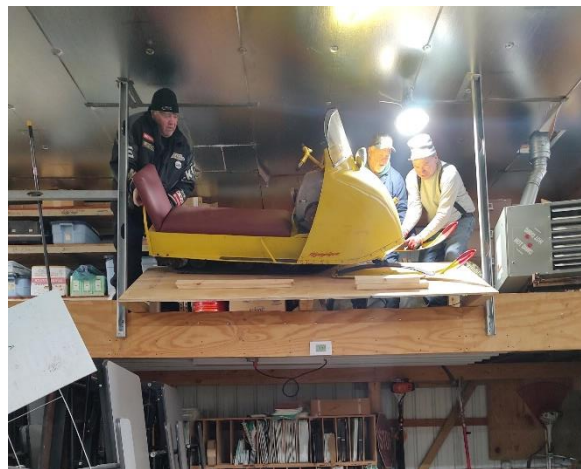
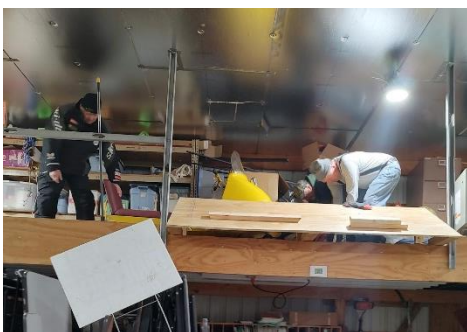


Russ enjoyed the sunset Sunday night as he and Steve C went out.

"Dairy Queen Dave" happened to stop by and helped get the Ski Doo up to the loft.

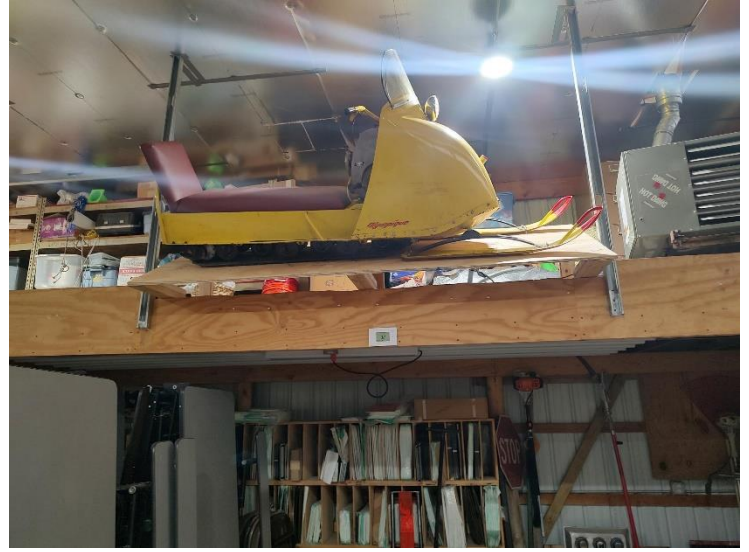


Lots of maneuvering to get it in place.

On display in the Clubhouse barn. It still needs something to explain what it is. Maybe the poster about it.



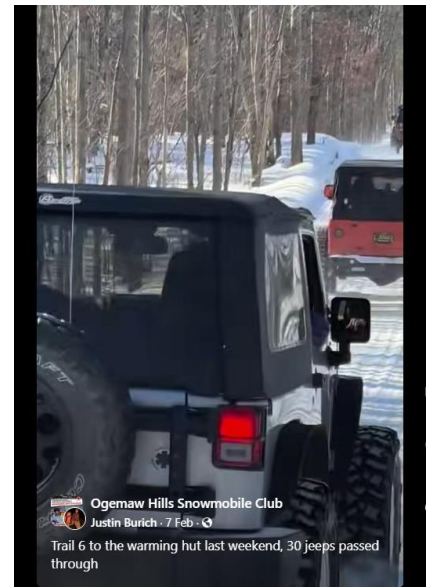
They hung the new tv in the barn for the Open House Show. Gary will run videos for people who are eating/warming there during the Show.
