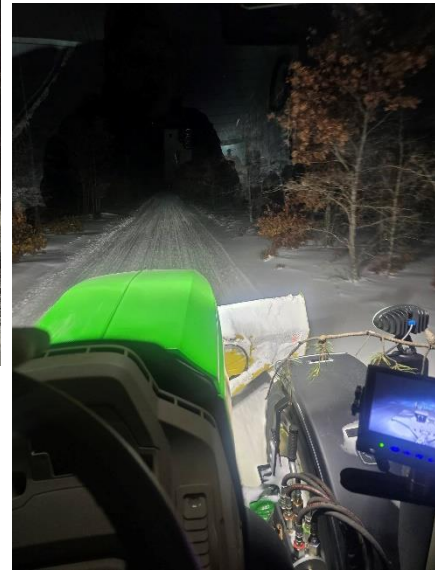


FEBRUARY / MARCH 2026 PHOTOS

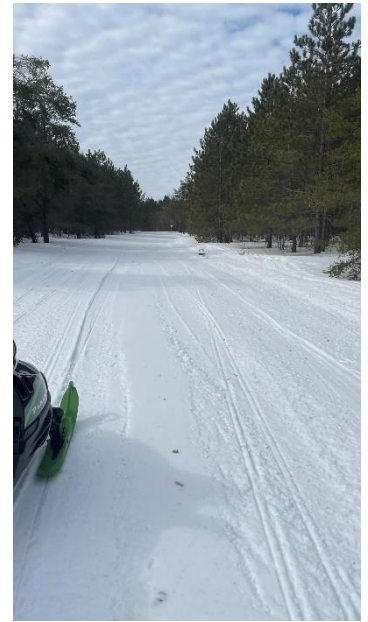




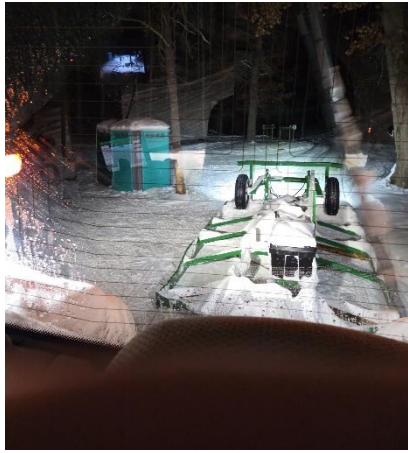
Adam Scott and the Tennessee boys on their last day.
